	<p>The internet is a great place to speak to lots of people, but it has to be a safe place too.</p>
	<p>If someone you have met online is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• speaking to you about sex• sending you pictures of their private parts• Asking you for pictures of your private parts <p>This could be online sexual violence.</p>



If someone does any of these things, think:

- How well do I know this person?
- Can I trust this person?
- Do I want this person to speak to me this way?
- Do I like what this person is saying?



If you don't know someone or feel you can't trust them, tell someone that supports you.



If you don't want them to speak to you in that way, or you don't like what they are saying, ask them to stop.

Then go and speak to someone that supports you.
